2012 Final Report

Twenty-Two was received very well. Harvest CROPS continues to gain momentum with residential calls, volunteers picking, and limited income families and seniors receiving the fresh-picked fruit. In addition, recognition for our community services is complimented with invitations. Invited to the 2012 Chaldean Community Awareness Presentation, we were introduced to Meals4Hunger, a 501(c)(3) public charity whose focus is on eradicating hunger in San Diego County and expanding the impact nationally. Together we supported the presentation in fighting obesity. Harvest CROPS has partnered with Meals4Hunger of San Diego. We are grateful to Tisha Tyler, Executive Director, for their decision and support.

This year Harvest CROPS was able to purchase the necessary equipment and materials for public outdoor and indoor awareness presentations or events. Now with a portable canopy, folding tables and chairs, literature tray holders, displayed picture frames and our banners, all that is left are the dates, locations, times and friendly volunteers to host. With encouragement, awareness and support, we can continue to provide fresh residential fruit in the public's best interest and benefit.

Our results for 2012 are:

- ❖ 39 houses visited
- ❖ 238 fruit trees picked,
- ❖ 1,376 miles traveled
- ❖ 344 volunteered
- ❖ 9,067 pounds collected
- ❖ \$13,300.00 given at \$0.75 a lb.
- ❖ \$394 in gasoline cost
- ❖ \$860 in grand total expenditures

Harvest CROPS averages about \$1.00 to each \$16.00 or 12 pounds of fruit given. For one dollar, Harvest CROPS provides about one week's of fresh fruit to each family. Residential fruit that would otherwise drop and rot is harvested and provided free to limited income families and seniors.
